There are two methods that we use to assess our learners during their End-Point Assessment. Each method accounts for 50% of the overall grade. So, in order for you to prepare your apprentice, we've provided some top tips below, to help them achieve the grade that they deserve.

Situational Judgement Test

Situational Judgment Test involves answering 60 multiple choice questions, in 90 minutes. Apprentices must complete the Situational Judgement Test before moving on to the Professional Discussion. These top tips below will help your apprentice achieve great results.

Make sure you understand the instructions



Make sure you know what you are being asked to do. You should go into the test well aware of what is expected of you and having watched our explanatory video.

Relax



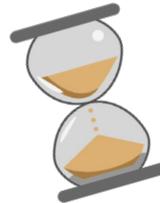
Ensure that you are comfortable - sit in your favorite chair with no stresses around you.

Zzz...

Try to get a good night's sleep the night before you take your exam.



Don't rush



You have 90 minutes for the test. Make sure you use your time in the way that best suits you, taking your time to answer each question.

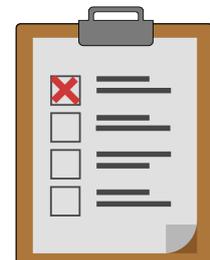
Check your internet connection is working



Always check that everything is working correctly. You don't want this to create stress and panic before you do your test.

Do a mock test

Mock tests are available and they will really help you understand the exam, how it works and the sorts of questions you will be asked.



Make sure you can't be disturbed

Being interrupted could be the difference between passing and failing, so make sure you're in a space without distractions or the risk of interruption.



Check your answers



When you complete the last question on the test, remember to review your answers and make sure that you're happy with the responses you have given.
